We promise to have and honor You to the last moment of our life *and to spread the worship of Your Sacred Heart as much as we can.*

Our Jesus, dispose of us according to Your good pleasure. We want to have no other reward than Your greater glory and Your holy love. Grant us grace to find our home in Your divine Heart. Here we wish to spend every day of our life; here we wish to breathe forth our last breath. Be pleased to set up in our heart Your dwelling place, the seat of Your rest, that we may thus remain inseparably united. *May we one day be able to love and possess You forever in the kingdom of heaven, where we shall praise without end the infinite mercies of Your Sacred Heart.*
