LEADER: Good morning, everyone! We now invite you to pray with us the Rosary with the following intentions: In thanksgiving for all the blessings and graces we received, for the intentions of the Holy Father, our Bishop Barber, clergy and religious, especially Fr. Dante, Fr. Jimmy, and Sr. Anitha. We also pray for our St. Callistus parish community, especially those suffering from this pandemic, and for the end of COVID. Finally, we include the souls in purgatory and the conversion of sinners.

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. *Amen.*

THE HOLY ROSARY

Apostles' Creed: I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, Our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell; the third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven, is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From thence He shall come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

Our Father, Who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. *Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.*

Hail, Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. *Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. Amen. (3x)*

Glory Be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. *As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.*

Fatima Prayer (ALL): O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of Hell and lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Thy mercy. Amen.

ALL: **Jesus, Mary, and Joseph,** we love you. Save souls, save the consecrated and the unborn.

Grant, we beseech Thee, that by meditating upon the mysteries of the most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain, and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ, Our Lord. *Amen.*

LEADER: May the divine assistance remain always with us,
ALL: *and may the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.*

Prayer to St. Michael (ALL): St. Michael, the Archangel, defend us in the day of battle. Be our defense against the wickedness and snares of the Devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray, and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly hosts, by the power of God, thrust into hell Satan, and all the evil spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

ALL: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
