Here are our announcements:

1. If you didn't hear during Ash Wednesday and as you witnessed during this Mass, in observance of the season of Lent, our music and singing will be toned down or minimized. That means the masses during Lent will be shorter. At the least, there will only be 4 music or songs to be played and sung. Though we highly encourage you to use the remaining time, after mass, for more private or family prayer in the church.
2. Our second Stations of the Cross is this Friday, February 27 at 7pm. The Ushers & Greeters Ministry will lead the prayers. The remaining four Fridays are also listed on screen. This is a spiritually enriching activity to do throughout Lent, so come join us every Friday!
3. If you didn't get them already, please pick-up items at the back of the pews or at the Vestibule after Mass. Get the Rice bowl box at the back of the pews. This is a great way to give alms to neighbors in need, locally and globally. The Rice bowl boxes with your offerings should be returned on Easter Sunday.
