4. Reminder that the distribution of the cup of Jesus' Precious Blood will begin next week on Corpus Christi Sunday, June 7 weekend. In reverence to the Lord, after receiving communion, please make a simple vow before you proceed to your pews if not receiving the Precious Blood.
5. Next weekend Sunday, June 7 the St. Callistus Safety Protocol closing of doors **15 minutes** AFTER Mass begins. This implementation includes the daily 9am Masses. For our benefit and safety, Fr. Dante and the Parish Council recommend the following instructions:
  - A. Arrive 10 minutes BEFORE Mass begins OR, best yet for the soul, attend the Rosary 1/2 hour before your Mass Time.
  - B. If you missed the cut-off time and the doors are closed when you arrive, you are highly encouraged to attend the next mass. Thank you for your kind understanding.
