1. Reminder that those who signed up for the Washing of the Feet at the Vestibule for the Last Supper of the Lord Mass on Holy Thursday, April 2, 7pm to please come to practice on Wed., April 1 at 7pm.
2. Holy Week is here. Please make sure to check the Triduum schedule. One change during that time is that we'll have the Rosary at 12pm on Good Friday, instead of the 7 Last Words of Jesus.
3. Please note that the Rectory office is closed this Good Friday, April 3.
4. After the 1pm Lord's Passion Service follows the Divine Mercy Novena at about 3pm. Our Lord appeared to St. Faustina in the 1920s thru the 1930s and requested one of nine of His intentions be prayed each day starting on Good Friday. After Good Friday until the following 1st Saturday of Easter, the Divine Mercy group will host the Great Hour of Mercy prayers from 3pm to 4pm that will include the Novena and Chaplet. More info to follow at the start of the Divine Mercy Novena.
5. Healing Mass and Adoration will be moved from 1st Saturday to 2nd Saturday for April only due to Holy Saturday and Easter solemnity. Please note that Healing Mass and adoration is on Saturday, April 11.
6. Next Easter Sunday, including Vigil, please bring your Rice Bowl with offering and place them in designated area.
7. The Easter Sunday Egg Hunt is after the 10am Mass on Easter Day. Kids 12 and under AND 85 and over may participate! Contact Lea Aguilar at (925) 222-0185, if you have questions.
8. Please note that we do not have Faith Formation on Easter Sunday. Sessions resume on Divine Mercy Sunday or Second Sunday of Easter.
