Here are our announcements:

1. On the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, we will have blessing of candles on Monday, February 2, during the 9am Mass. Pls bring your candles to be blessed.
2. On the Feast Day of St. Blaise on Tuesday, February 3, there will be Blessing of Throats during the 9am Mass.
3. February 7th is 1st Saturday, so we'll have the 9am Anointing of the Sick Mass followed by the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament through 12pm. The Fellowship Prayer Group will lead prayers at 11am until Benediction. All are welcome.
4. Mark your calendars - Ash Wednesday is just 2 1/2 weeks away on February 18th. Prior to that, we request last year's palms be dropped off the next two weekends: February 7-8 and 14-15. You may deposit them in a basket provided at the back of the pews.
5. With Lent coming soon beginning Ash Wednesday, as in previous years, parishioners will gain benefits from handouts to guide and potentially gain spiritual fruits through Lent.
