## St. Callistus Church Parking Lot instructions during the El Sobrante Stroll

The El Sobrante Stroll parking lot notice for St. Callistus parishioners will be distributed the first weekend of September. The notice will provide information about the issuing of parking passes and the closure of parking lot entrances and exits on the day of the Stroll.

**St. Callistus Parking Lot Passes** will be distributed the second weekend of September following each mass. The parking lot passes will be divided into **three stacks of 90**, for each Sunday mass. Parking passes will also be distributed after Saturday Vigil mass to choir members who will return to church on Sunday to sing and parishioners who also attend mass on Sunday. They will receive a parking pass according to the mass (8, 10 or 12) if they plan to attend. The remaining passes will be given to the parish office for distribution.

## The Day of the El Sobrante Stoll Parking Procedures

The vehicle <u>entrance and exits</u> opening on the Walgreen side will be chained off during the El Sobrante Stroll. No traffic will be allowed to enter or exit in that direction. **Nor will <u>traffic be</u>** <u>allowed to enter the church parking lot to pass through to Walgreens.</u>

Vehicles will only be allowed to **enter and exit on San Pablo Dam Road with an issued parking pass.** Assigned people will be posted at both the entrance and exit of San Pablo Dam Road to pick up parking passes. There will be people who will claim to have forgotten their pass who may be known or not known to be parishioners. It will be at the discretion of the personnel in charge to determine whether a person is allowed into the parking lot or not.

A parking lot **turnabout will be set up on the Walgreen side**, yellow cones will be set up utilizing 6 parking spaces. During the beginning and end of mass people will be posted on the parking lot to aid parishioners in maneuvering in and out of the parking lot.

The parking restrictions will remain into effect only to the **end of the noon mass** on Sunday.

After the noon mass the chains closing the parking entrance and exit on the Walgreens side will be removed and the yellow cones setting up the parking lot turnabout will also be removed.
