1. St. Callistus launched a new Parish Safety Ministry and we are appealing to all parishioners who feel called to participate in creating protocol, procedures, coordinate training and working with volunteers to ensure our parish safety during masses. Pls sign up in the vestibule after mass.

3. This year, the Feast of The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary falls on next Sat, August 15. The feast day is not a holy day of obligation this year.

Parents need to sign up during our SVdP Pantry hours Monday and Thursday from 11am to noon before the event. Last day to apply is Thursday, August 20. Requirements include school ID or other proof of age and parents must be present with their children at the Sketchers Back to School event on August 22 from 8AM- 9 AM at Sketchers in El Cerrito.
5. Parents who are placing their child or children in our Faith Formation Program next month should register for both thru rectory and on Flocknote, if not already done. Confirmation sessions also resumes Sunday, September 23 for those already in the 2025-2027 program. Those who want to start their confirmation program may apply next year for the 2027-2029 batch.
