2. Reminder that All Saints Day this coming Friday, Nov. 1 is a Holy day of obligation. Masses are offered at 9am & 7pm.

Place the envelopes in the basket provided in the sanctuary. The names will be read at 8am on All Souls Day, Saturday, November 2. Also, your deceased loved-ones will be blessed after each Mass in the whole month of November.
4. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament follows the Memorial Mass on 1st Sat., Nov. 2 thru 12pm. Since All Soul's Day falls on the 1st Saturday in November, the Anointing of the Sick Mass will be moved to November 9th, 2nd Saturday next month.
